Papers and publications

Authors can submit either the full paper or the abstract. Each author may submit a maximum of three papers, with no more than one paper where they are the first author. Authors are required to prepare their papers according to the guidelines available on the symposium website (www.symopis2025.fon.bg.ac.rs) and submit them electronically, following the instructions.

Accepted papers will be published in the Proceedings in Serbian or English and a Book of abstracts will also be published. Selected papers presented at the Symposium will be proposed for publication in selected journals, including the Yugoslav Journal of Operations Research - YUJOR. The extended and revised versions of the papers must undergo the regular peer review process of the journal.

Official languages of the Symposium are Serbian and English.
